- 1. An untested source advised a representative of this Agency that Agustin YASSELS Gonzalez had arrived in Kingston, Janaica, on 23 May 1962. YASSELS spent the night at the home of Alfonso HERRIRA Perdono; the Cuban Consul in Kingston, and traveled to Toronbo, Canada, on 29 May 1962. YASSELS held Cuber Diplometic passport D/62/200, issued in Habana, Cuba, on 6 April 1962. His birth date was listed as 16 May 1939.
- In a report dated 30 July 1962, an untested source identified Agustin YASSELES Conzalez as a Cuban courier who accompanied angel TATO Ramirez, a Cuban inspector, to Kingston, Jamaica, in April 1962.
- This Agency's representative in Kingston, Jamaica, reported on 11 September 1962, that Agustin YASSELLS Gonzalez, a Cuban courier, received a United States visa on 10 September 1963;

Source first met YASSEL in April 1959 when both attended a lilitary Attache course in Cludad Mar, Santiago de Cuba; YASSEL, at that time, was a Second Lieutenant in the Cuban Rebel Army. During the period source was in Montevideo (Octween mid-March and mit-May 1962), he met YASSEL again when YASSEL visited the Cuban Embassy on two occasions as a Ciplomatic courier. YASSEL's courier run took him from Mabana to Exico-Chile-Uruguay-Brazil and back to Habana. Source, sometime in 1962, say YASSEL in MINREX in Habana. Source also said that he is certain that YASSEL is a Cuban Intelligence Service functionary and a Communist. He described YASSEL as having been born about 1935, being five feet seven inches tall, 160 pounds, with black hair, dark eyes, a dark complexion, and having a modium build.
