Headquarters Comments

The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

1. Luis PEREZ, alias "Bruno Diaz" and "El Polaco," is a captain in the Cuban army who heads the Departamento Escuelas Especiales (Department of Special Schools - EE) in theDireccion General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGII). In 1959 he served in some Latin American country as Military Attaché.

2. PEREZ, a Caucasian, was born in approximately 1935, he is five feet ten inches tall, weighs 170 pounds, and has a strong build. He always dresses in an olive green military uniform.¹
