1. Arturo HERNANDEZ Telleria was a sergeant in BATISTA's police force; he accompanied BATISTA when he was overthrown and escaped to Santo Domingo. After a few days HERNANDEZ returned to Habana. HERNANDEZ is now the Chief of Archives of the Direccion General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGI).

2. HERNANDEZ was born sometime prior to 1919. He is five feet nine inches tall, 180 pounds, has a heavy build, and gray hair 1,2,3
