

- 1. On 4 February 1965, AMMUG/1 was shown a photograph of Mischail K. SAMOILOV, a Soviet diplomat, in an attempt to possibly identify FAMOILOV as "El Frances" who has been reported as the Soviet advisor to the Directorio General de Inteligencia (DGI). AMMUG/1 thought the photograph was of a Soviet he had seen in Cuba but he could not state this definitely nor could he identify this individual as "El Frances".
- 2. The possible connection of the identity of "El Frances" with SAMOILOV developed when his name appeared along with that of Manuel PINE/RO, Chief of the DGI, on a passenger manifest of a flight to Czechoelovakia. The manifest was forwarded to Headquarters as an attuchment to OCOA-7878 dated 15 May 1964.
