SUBJECT: Project LIEMPTY Renewal

1. The Foreign Intelligence Staff recommends renewal of Project LIEMPTY.

2. It is recommended that the Division and Mexico City Station make a special effort during the next year to assess the value of each indigenous support agent. We hope it will be possible to eliminate several agents and to reduce project cost accordingly.


