X They should have appologise of course, but I'm very, very glad

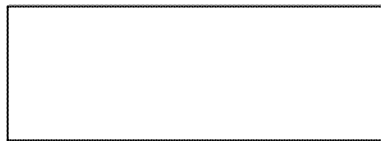
