FREAPANE was introduced to Subject in February 1959 by AMDERETTE-9 in Havana to provide FREAFANE with first-band information concerning the postrevolutionary high level labor activities and to aid in the development of Project AMCALL

Subject's motivation is tied up in his religious convictions. He is a trained. rilitant Roman Catholic whose repeated, outspoken pronouncements against Communism in the Cuban labor accement are a matter of record.
