- 1. Subject of reference is identical with Carlos Arturo BONILLA Samples (201-273728), president of the pro-Communist Federation of Workers of Cundinamerea (FTC). Insemuch as Subject's 201 file was sent to Boadquarters in July 1963 the Station does not have a complete record of Subject's background and relationship, if any, with the Soviets.
- 2. The cost recent information in the Station's files on Subject, who has been serive in Communist labor unions since 1945, in that he attended the Soviet Anniversary calebrations hold in a theater in Bogota in early Rovember 1944 after which he want to Rayana, via Maxico, on 27 Hovember 1964 on special invitation of Fidel Costro. In early December 1964 CITMBLOS/10, who is considered a reliable source, reported that Augusto Duron, a former leader of the Communist Party of Colombia. (PCC) and former of the FTC, issued orders that the FTC should form an alliance with the PCC. This source added that in view of Bonilla's trip to Cuba this infermetica indicated possibilities of such a union.
- 3. It is suggested that Readquarters review Subject's file and notify the Station Herico City and Bogots of any relationship between Subject and the Soviets, aspecially Hikolay Sergeyovich LECEOV (201-132139) and Alchandr Hikhaylovich EROVKIE (201-183114).
