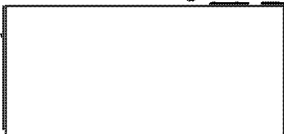

1. It is requested that a Provisional Covert Security Approval and a Covert Security Approval be granted to permit the use of [redacted] as follows:

a. To serve as an air crew member aboard FBILKA aircraft performing flights of a sensitive nature within the controlled areas of the Far East and Southeast Asia.
