P-R-I-O-R-I-T-Y

1. It is requested that a REVOLUT Cuban passport be issued to UNRELEASABLE/2, a Cuban citizen. Is one of the key workers assets working on local Cuban operations. His Cuban passport expires on 7 January 1963. In view of a long history of anti-Castro activities locally and in Cuba, it is doubtful that UNRELEASABLE/2 could obtain a passport through the local Cuban Consulate, in spite of the fact that to date, the Cuban Government has issued passports to any Cuban who has applied for one.

2. This new passport, issued in his true name, is essential for UNRELEASABLE/2 to continue his studies in France, as well as his operational function for the Station. Since France has not yet decided to give anti-Castro Cubans in France refugee status, UNRELEASABLE/2 will be without documentation after January 1963. UNRELEASABLE/2 stated that he had procured several "false passports" for student friends of his through the Revolutionary Committee in Miami. UNRELEASABLE/2 would prefer not to involve himself personally in the Revolutionary Committee at this time, with a request for a passport for himself.

3. If this is within the possibility of the Station in Germany, and approved by Headquarters, it is requested that this passport be issued prior to the end of 1962. In the event that this type of documentation cannot be provided for UNRELEASABLE/2, a prompt reply would be appreciated.

4. Forwarded under separate cover is a biographic description of UNRELEASABLE/2, for inclusion in a new passport. Also forwarded are photographs of UNRELEASABLE/2. The photographs are designed as appears to be the custom in Cuban passports.
