Reference is made to my letter dated June 26, 1959, in captioned matter.

A source with whom sufficient contact has not been had to determine his reliability on July 1, 1959, advised our representative in Havana, Cuba, he had learned that four Russians are presently training Cuban military personnel at a farm known as El Cortijo. The source further advised that the identities of the Russians were not known.

With regard to the above information, our representative has advised that Pedro Luis Diaz Lanz, the former head of the Cuban Air Force, in his letter of resignation to President Manuel Urrutia stated that communist elements have exerted pressure to achieve a determined plan of indoctrination in the school that functions at El Cortijo farm.

The above information has been made available to appropriate officials in the United States Embassy at Havana, Cuba. Any additional pertinent information received in this matter will be immediately made available.
