**Subject:** HSCA review issues and tomorrow's scheduled meeting at NARA  
Jeremy, Tom and I had a long discussion this afternoon with Steve Tilley about the status of the HSCA records, whether they have been processed by NARA, and whether any have been referred. He explained that they in fact have been preliminarily processed (meaning they all are or should be in the computer even though the printout identification aids are not attached [though Steve agreed they should have been]). However, because they raise issues that the task force personnel at the time did not feel equipped to resolve (like referral of state and local records, which apparently raises some big issues for the Archives) and because they were reviewed under severe time constraints, he agreed with our initial impression that they do need additional processing or referral before they are presented to the Board. We jointly came to a tentative solution, subject to your approval, that we would postpone tomorrow's meeting until Diane Dimkoff and her staff can go through the documents, make a comprehensive list of what remains to be processed, figure out what can be dealt with immediately and what needs additional discussion, and send the list to us so that we can move forward on this. Please let me know if this approach is all right with you and I can call her tomorrow morning to reschedule.
