WASHINGTON (AP) _ Senate Republicans named three new committee chairmen to fill openings resulting from former Finance Committee Chairman Bob Packwood's resignation. Sen. William Roth Jr., R-Del., moves up to the high-profile Finance chairmanship, leaving his position as head of the Governmental Affairs Committee. Sen. Ted Stevens, R-Alaska, who had been chairman of the Rules Committee, takes over as chairman of the Governmental Affairs Committee. Sen. John Warner, R-Va., who did not have a previous chairmanship, becomes chairman of the Rules Committee. Packwood resigned as Finance chairman Friday and promised to leave the Senate Oct. 1 rather than face a vote on an Ethics Committee recommendation that he be expelled for sexual and official misconduct.
