Tierney, a former chairman of the Interstate Commerce Commission who later headed the Transportation Association of America, died of a heart attack Wednesday. He was 79. Tierney began his government service as an FBI agent, and in 1953 joined the staff of the Senate Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations as an assistant to then-general counsel Robert F. Kennedy. He also worked with Kennedy on the Senate Rackets Committee. He was appointed to the ICC in 1963, serving as its chairman from 1967 to 1968. He joined the transportation association in 1970 as vice president and retired 10 years later as president. Tierney leaves his wife, Ann; five children and 12 grandchildren.
