I've searched through the list of HSCA Public Exhibits published at the end of the Report. I don't find any reference to a mock-up of Dealey plaza, either HSCA-generated or borrowed from the Warren Commission. I did find two references to a "Topographic Survey Map of Dealey Plaza", referenced as exhibits F-133 and F-672. I believe it's one map that was used on two separate occasions. If you look at the map as published in the HSCA Volumes, it clearly denotes that it was put together by a Dallas firm expressly for the HSCA. This may be the map Kris at NARA I was telling me about. Next time I talk to her (she owes me a call) I'll ask her to look at the map/artifact and see if there are any identifying exhibit numbers on it.
