Since the National Archives had told me the best video format was digital beta cam, the following information is based on using these high-quality tapes: The price of copying is \$108.00 per hour. The price per tape is \$82.00. The inventory of the WETA tapes shows that they probably have five days of hearing in their archives (9/6/78, 9/7/78, 9/8/78, 9/13/78 and 12/29/78). Based on 8 hour days (maybe less than that) times five days, would be 40 hours of hearings. At \$108 per hour, the cost of copying would be \$4,320. The cost of 20 tapes (two hours on each tape) at \$82.00 each would be \$1,640. GRAND TOTAL (ESTIMATE): \$5,960.00 In response to my inquiry about a possible discount, he stated that they did not do that. He said that there is always the possibility that they could come in under the estimate. I told Corbley that I would get back to him and advise him what we wanted to do.
