**Subject:** More HSCA contact with NODA files

**Body:** I've come up with some documentation of additional HSCA staffer persual of NODA Garrison files, this time in the person of Martin J. Daly. There is a 3/20/78 OCR by Daly which indicates that he met with Connick and, as a result, was delegated to Lt. Comstock. Comstock was the one who informed Daly (and, through him, the HSCA for what appears to be the first time) that he, Comstock, had in his office a five-drawer file cabinet of Garrison material, re: Shaw trial. Daly relates in his OCR that he "perused" these files, and copied a limited number of documents (12). Most of these copies can be located in the same HSCA file as the OCR. The OCR is an original document, with Daly's original signature. This is chronologically prior to the Palmer/Orr visit of April '78. On 5/17/78 (after the Palmer/Orr), there are two more Daly-Comstock OCRs, both originals, referencing Daly as having met with Comstock, re: various records. Of perhaps some note is that on this visit Comstock actually turned over to Daly (and it is in the HSCA folder in our SCIF) an actual New Orleans Public Library card -- for Clem Bertrand. Not a copy of a card -- the original (although no doubt forged!) card/artifact.
