**Subject:** Possible Steps Relative to Ballistics

Get independent experts.6. Determine what additional testing can demonstrate.7. Determine what harm, if any, will come to the fragments as a result of additional testing.8. Interview HSCA Firearms Panel Members (particularly Champagne and Bates, since we have their CE 567 worksheets.9. Acquire any additional records which HSCA Firearms Panel members may still

have in their possession.10. Test CE 567 fiber.11. Discuss possibility of follow through on HSCA recommendation on Bronson film, acoustics evidence, and any other reasonable steps that can be taken
