I telephonically contacted Ms. deBarona of the Special Collections Division of the University of Miami library to ask her about Manuel Salvat's donation of DRE records. She has not yet received the complete donation from Salvat, but she has talked with him twice since I last contacted her (07May96). She told me that he will be busy with other items until 05June96, and after that he will have more time to concentrate on getting the documents over to the library. She recommended that I call her again in a month to check on the status. I took this opportunity to ask her again about obtaining some kind of formal index for these records. She said that she would be happy to provide us with any kind of index that comes along with the donation. However, she said that due to a heavy workload, it would be impossible (emphasis hers) for the library staff to provide anything more than that. She recommended that we talk to Salvat himself. I informed her that we had tried to contact him but he would not return our calls. My suggestion: Perhaps we should try to contact him again, or, when we have confirmation that the library has received the materials, we should send a formal letter which would require them to respond to our request for an index. It seems as if she would rebuff any verbal request for an index.
