At the Pentagon yesterday, I tracked down what could turn out to be a promising lead in getting the ARRB story out to military personnel. It turns out there is something called the Armed Forces Press Service, a sort of military wire service that provides stories to more than 1600 installation newspapers at US military bases. I met with their Pentagon correspondent, who asked that we fax her info on ARRB and our search for military records, etc. I've asked Chris B. to work with Tom to get her what she needs; hopefully, we'll get some good blanket coverage out of this. We're continuing to pursue Army/Navy/Air Force Times, as well as Retired Officer magazine (published monthly by Retired Officers Association). Our goal with all this would be not only to (perhaps) get records, but possibly also establish contact with people who, for example, were on duty in the NMCC when the assassination occurred.
