FYI. Duggar was an editor of the Texas Observer and a special correspondent for the Washington Post at the time of the assassination. He is also described as a long-time acquaintance of Asst. DA Bill Alexander. There are two references in HSCA documents to the fact that Ron Duggar has notebooks from the weekend of the assassination, as well as later summaries of interviews (1973) with Alexander, Henry Wade and the Johnsons (Beckley St. landlords). He later ends up in Charlottesville, VA, as some kind of Professor at UVA.
