A quick check in our own computer database yields 147 responses to a search on "Beckham" (as opposed to Griffith's 169). I don't have an explanation for the discrepancy but, in any case, only 15 of these 147 are listed in our database as referred or postponed. Of these 15, 3 were cleared by the CIA as consent releases at our May 14 Board meeting. An additional 3 (of the 15) were on the consent agenda for this week's Board meeting. These latter three include a 20-page 8/9/77 HSCA interview with Beckham which could be the one that Garrison is talking about in his phone call with Gandolfo, and which Griffith is interested in. So six of the fifteen have been processed since May. Two more, upon inspection, appear to be copies of the same 8/9/77 interview referenced above, and so should be able to be released -- either by the Board as duplicates or by the CIA as consent releases -- at the next meeting. I've attached copies of the relevant RIFs (annotated in upper-right hand corner) to a hardcopy of this E-mail. Hope this helps with Griffith.
