Subject: Return Call From Stephanie Fawcett, Kennedy Library (HARD COPY BEING FAXED WITH ATTACHMENTS)
I received a return call from Stephanie Fawcett of the Kennedy Library today (per my last meeting with Mary Kennefick, I had left a message for Mary on Friday to check on the status of the work on the database). Stephanie told me the following:
1. They were still having trouble with the data base and had not yet accessed the disk. Attempts are being made to enter the changes in the database. She hoped to talk with Steve Tilley to resolve their problems.
2. There are 17 documents which the Library describes as "pending review." As you will see from the attached list (just received by fax this morning), most of them are at DOD. I told Stephanie that we would look at the list and see what we could do to expedite agency review.
3. 105 documents are being sent from the Library to Edy Price, of NARA at College Park, by DOD courier plane, tomorrow, September 20. Stephanie said that she had sent "top secret" documents to Price that were for the Board in the past and this procedure had worked out fine. As previously discussed, these are documents which have postponements or have never been reviewed under the JFK Act and were deemed "exempt" under the old executive order. As you are aware, the plan is that the Board will attempt to expedite the review of the documents with the relevant federal agencies. I mentioned to Stephanie that I wanted to run through the Library's compliance response with them and she reiterated that Megan had written the response and it was best to speak with her. Megan is not available until Thursday. I will try to talk with her then to discuss the various issues that all of us discussed on the telephone last week. Please advise me of any comments, questions, suggestions or issues that need to be raised with the Library. Note to Jeremy: I have now received the FedEx sent by Cathy that contained your book on the presidential schedules, appointments, etc. If you are available, I will call you tomorrow to discuss the contents and the next step with the Library. Please advise me what time you are available to talk on the phone.
