Subject: Fritz Notes-Conversation with Max Holland

Max noted something interesting in the Fritz notes. On page 1, Fritz references Oswald in response to questioning from Hosty, admitting to "wrighting (sic) to Russian Embassy + to Hosty" (emphasis added). This appears to be an admission by Oswald that he wrote to Hosty (is it the notorious note later destroyed by the FBI?) I thought this was very interesting. FBI Agent James Bookout may have some interesting recollections of this session. Have we ever talked to him? Do we know if he is alive? Could Laura find out from Carol? Perhaps he has notes that should be pursued, either from him or his family. I didn't check his testimony, so I don't know off hand what he said to the Warren Commission
