1. Congressional letter looks good.2. A letter arrived today from a member of the public (Dr. Larry Haapanen--Idaho) who wrote after seeing a story on the Fritz notes. He believes that USSS SA Forrest Sorrels also may have had notes of an interrogation of Oswald. He writes that there is documentation of Sorrels' interrogations of Jack Ruby, but at the top of one of the pages of notes (WC Sorrels exhibit 3-A) there are notes that appear to pertain to Oswald ("since 15-read Marxism/went to Soviet union to see it in practice"). He thinks that there may be notes on an interrogation of Oswald by Sorrels. I left a copy of the letter in your in-box.
