Michelle will forward something to your regarding CIA's responses to our requests. On the document front: At the January meeting the Board voted on 710 green CIA documents. This is our highest total to date. The numbers must continue to increase, but this is a move in the right direction. Also, CIA has informed us that they have added additional reviewers and indexers. This should help them process even more records each month. In addition, we have established weekly meetings with CIA for the sole purpose of evaluating statistics of the review process. These meetings should permit us to more closely monitor the pace of review. This suggests CIA's willingness to cooperate and realistically evaluate the progress of this project.
