DoughertyDescription of the Call Date: 02/20/98Subject: Treasury ComplianceSummary of the Call:David Dougherty, the attorney at the Treasury Department who is overseeing JFK Act compliance, called me this morning to inform us that Treasury sent its assassination records to the JFK Collection at NARA on February 11, 1998. Mr. Dougherty informed me that the Secret Service approved their equities in these records and that no postponements were being claimed. The records consist of files relating to Treasury's work with the Church Committee and the HSCA. Mr. Dougherty estimated the volume to be 200 documents (500 pages). The Final Declaration of Compliance for Treasury will be submitted shortly. Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
