THE SIXTH FLOOR would like to acquire it. No decision has been made.The ARRB needs to acquire a duplicate copy for their records accumulation.Qualified JFK photo researchers need to study it in detail, although I when I saw it 20 years ago, I saw anything of evidentiary value.Jack White
