I received Deborah Conway's voice mail request for the USSS report on President Kennedy's Chicago trip. The "135 forms" for Secret Service holdings at Suitland indicate that the Secret Service created three file folders of material dated November 2, 1963, for President Kennedy's trip to Chicago. Unfortunately, these folders were in Box 6 of accession no. 87-75-4, which the Secret Service destroyed in January 1995. The HSCA had requested information about these reports, and portions of the Chicago trip report have survived in the HSCA collection. Ms. Conway should request this portion using the following numbers: [180-10113-10084], [180-10113-10085], and [180-10113-10086]. She might supplement this trip report with additional reports from Chicago on Thomas Vallee: [180-10080-10153] and [180-10080-10154]. The HSCA gathered a considerable amount of information on Vallee, and these reports are in the HSCA collection under agency file number 008581. There are over twenty additional reports on Vallee. Two additional bits of info:1. A trip report for President Kennedy's trip to Chicago on March 23, 1963, has survived, and it is open in the Archives. It does not have a RIF on it. She would have to request it directly by date from Steve Tilley. It is in Box 5 of the accession mentioned above.2. The Review Board just designated the Abraham Bolden file an "assassination record," and when it becomes available she will find additional information about the Secret Service office in Chicago in
