The Review Board is the independent federal agency overseeing the identification, review, and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The bill, H.R. 1553, was signed into law by the President on July 3, 1997. It amends the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records CollectionAct of 1992 to extend the authorization of the Assassination Records ReviewBoard until September 30, 1998, and authorizes \$1.6 million for the Boardto complete its work.
