Chet checked the data disk John Machado brought last week. The USSS has agreed to release the remaining protective surveys without appeal. In response to our request of October 1996, The Secret Service has now released 46 protective surveys for President Kennedy that cover the period January, 1963, through September, 1963. The total number of pages is 1,981. Since January 1996, the Secret Service has placed a total of 8,200 pages of material in the JFK Collection at NARA. These new records supplement the Secret Service's Official Case File, which that agency placed in the National Archives in 1979.
