Kennedy, announced today that it has released the original personal papers of the late Clay Shaw, the New Orleans businessman charged with conspiracy to murder President Kennedy. Shaw was acquitted after a jury trial in 1969. Shaw, who died in 1974, was charged as part of the Kennedy assassination investigation conducted by the late New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison. The papers were kept by one of Shaw's friends until earlier this year when he donated the materials to the Review Board. The collection includes Shaw's diary that chronicled his life after being arrested for conspiring to kill the President, records from his criminal case, correspondence, business records, his passports, personal records and photographs. The New Orleans chapter of the Kennedy assassination story and the whole Garrison investigation is still debated and surrounded by controversy, said Dr. Kermit Hall, a member of the Review Board. The acquisition of the Clay Shaw papers means that historians and the public will now have the benefit of the personal perspective of the only man ever tried in connection with the assassination of
