Kennedy. The Review Board voted to release 406 CIA records in part. These documentspertain mostly to cable traffic to and from Mexico City regarding operational considerations and personnel matters, in addition to documents that relate to anti-Castro activities and Jim Garrison?s allegations of CIAinvolvement in the assassination. An additional 1,216 CIA documents willalso be open in full by consent release. The Board also voted to release 308 FBI documents in part from the HSCAsubject files. This marks the first significant release of records fromthese files. Subjects include J.U.R.E., Francis Martello, Carlos Marcello, and Bernardo G. DeTorres Alvarez. In addition, 956 FBI records will beopen in full by consent release. In addition, the Board voted to release 118 HSCA records in part. Theserecords are HSCA documents with CIA equities, and are part of the CIA?s?Sequestered Collection.? They consist in large part of an inventory ofCIA and Warren Commission files reviewed by the HSCA, as well as documents relating to Oswald in Mexico City and Russia, and CIA assassination plotsagainst Castro.
