The board considered 214 documents at the October meeting, over 3/4 of which came from the CIA. Cable traffic to and from Mexico City regarding operational details and personnel matters made up a significant portion of the 176 CIA documents. Travel orders and detailed reports on various CIA personnel and a few documents dealing with Oswald, de Morenschildt, and other individuals related to the assassination made up the remainder of the documents considered. The 38 HSCA documents that were considered dealt primarily with Oswald, his background and his life after he left Russia, security issues regading Cuba and the testimonies of CIA personnel before the HSCA.Any questions, let me know...
