I would like one more chance to lobby for inclusion of the 1/31/64 document into your press release package for November 18th.Perhaps when you see what I have drawn arrows next to on that one, you will agree with me. It is the only indicator in our pile of 6 (5 plus 1) documents for the media that the entire debate in 1963 changed from "overt military intervention" based on a long shopping list of pretexts, to "contingency plan for a(n) (instigated) coup," in which the only acceptable pretext becomes a military coup, and "contingency plan" means military intervention, on some scale. That evolution in thinking by the Cuban task force (ICCCA) is a big part of the story.
