After all this time, it was nice to be able to put a voice to the name, while remaining unable to put a face. However, who can predict the future ? Thank you for offering to let me have by post the documents the ARRB hold. It is, as usual, very much appreciated. Referring to the remaining 1500 records pertaining to the Army and the Joint Chiefs of Staff, can you help further ? I am particularly interested in establishing what the documents from the Summer and Autumn (Fall) of 1963 have to say. This especially applies to several military types (including a General Carroll, the head of the Defense Intelligence Agency, as well as the work of Cyrus Vance, Joseph Califano and Alexander Haig) who were involved in operations against Castro at that time. However, if I write to NARA I can expect a reply in about 6-9 months at the earliest I am told. Is there any way you know of to 'short circuit ' this process? What I am looking for is some way of establishing which of those 1500 documents relate to the work of these individuals during that period of time, together with some indication of what they contain and ,if possible, the relevant RIF numbers. I know its a great and laborious task but any thoughts/ideas you may have would be welcome. I do hope to have the opportunity of speaking to you directly again in the future.
