The HSCA documents include notesof CIA files and cables, primarily regarding biographical information onindividuals such as Luisa Calderon, Leo Cherne, Barney Hidalgo, andMohammed Reggab. An additional 290 CIA documents and two HSCA documentswill be open in full by consent release.FBI RecordsThe Board also voted to release 678 FBI documents, two in full and 676 inpart. The majority of these documents are from the HSCA subject files, which contain issues that the HSCA investigated as potentially relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy.
