Kennedy. In addition to this total, 108 Warren Commission documents will be open in full by consent release. CIA Records The Review Board voted to release 215 CIA documents in part. The majority of these records are from the ?Sequestered Collection.? The CIA documents relate primarily to cable traffic to and from Mexico City regarding administrative and operational matters. The HSCA documents include notes of CIA files and cables, primarily regarding biographical information on individuals such as Luisa Calderon, Leo Cherne, Barney Hidalgo, and Mohammed Reggab. An additional 290 CIA documents and two HSCA documents will be open in full by consent release. FBI Records The Board also voted to release 678 FBI documents, two in full and 676 in part. The majority of these documents are from the HSCA subject files, which contain issues that the HSCA investigated as potentially relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy.
