The remaining 1116 documents are postponed in part. Although the Review Board voted on a few documents from the "core and related" files, the majority of the documents originated in the HSCA subject files. Most of the HSCA subjects contain records that shed at least some light on issues that the HSCA explored as potentially relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Review Board voted on documents from HSCA subjects such as: Sam Giancana, Jack Caesar Grossi, La Cosa Nostra, Gabriel Mannarino, Sam Mannarino, Pedro Diaz Lanz, Edward Browder, Jr., John Orion Pittman, and Frank Sturgis.  
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
