Transfer of USSS Records to the JFK CollectionThe Assassination Records Review Board has been advised that the Secret Service, while responding to a separate Review Board request, located four films from the Service's Office of Training. One of the films is a copy of the Zapruder film, one is entitled "John F. Kennedy Assassination Re-enactment", a 20 minute film produced by the Secret Service, the third film is entitled "John F. Kennedy Assassination (Orville Nix and Mary Muchmore films)", and the fourth film, "Murder of Lee Harvey Oswald", is CBS News footage of the shooting of Oswald. These films have been transferred to the National Archives and Records Administration for inclusion in the JFK Assassination Records Collection.
