Dear Ms. Sullivan: The Fenton Report should be a record, the summary of New Orleans evidence by early HSCA staffer Cliff Fenton to first Chief Counsel Richard Sprague. A number of people at the time were aware that Fenton had made such a report to Sprague, and more learned of it later. It is possible that accounts became garbled, and that the report was actually one TO Fenton from his New Orleans investigators Bob Buras and L.J. Delsa, passed on to Sprague.
