Kennedy, announced today that it has acquired original records from James P. Hosty, Jr., a former FBI agent who was assigned to the investigation of Lee Harvey Oswald before the assassination. Among the records received are notes that, according to Hosty, he wrote on the afternoon of November 22, 1963, during an interrogation of Oswald within hours of his arrest by the Dallas
