Subject: inquiry about Manchester papers

Edward Klein (212-831-5110), author of All Too Human, and contributing editor to both Vanity Fair and Parade magazine, called to ask about whether or not the Manchester papers were on our radar. After checking the correspondence file, I let Mr. Klein know that we have only expressed interest in reviewing these papers. I also told Mr. Klein that I have not been involved in this issue and that I am unfamiliar with the legalities, if there are any. I told him that someone (possibly me) would call him back. Background: He is working on a sequel to his book, which is supposed to be finished in May, for publication in October. I told him that no matter where we are on this issue, he shouldn't count on a resolution to this by May for inclusion in his book. He did mention that he is interested anyway, in that he is a contributing editor for two magazines. He also mentioned that his lawyer is looking into this.
