Vince: All broadcast footage by all three networks is available to any researcher who cares to examine it. The Museum of Broadcasting (branches in New York and Chicago) maintains complete news archives, available for research (probably by prior arrangement). The only material unavailable is outtakes from CBS specials, and probably other outtakes, though even some of those have become available over the years. It's not clear whether they are suppressing evidence so much as keeping "exclusive new footage" to use in attracting audiences to future specials. Your compilation for Dealey Plaza UK includes some interesting points. The only thing, by the way, that was deleted from "The Kennedy Tapes" was duplication--otherwise, it's the complete footage for the period covered, and extremely valuable for including the uncut WFAA-TV footage of a number of cameramen.
