against testimonyWASHINGTON (Reuters) - The head of the Secret Service has warnedprosecutorsthat forcing his agents to testifyin the White House sex-and-perjury probe will result in the death of apresident, the Washington Post reported onThursday. The Post quoted sources familiar with the discussions as saying thatSecretService Director Lewis Merletti warnedindependent counsel Kenneth Starr that an assassination would beinevitable in the future because presidents would keep agents at a distance out of fear of losing their privacy. The issue of whether Secret Service agents are covered by a privilegeprotecting them from questioning will be airedin a rare open hearing before U.S. District Judge Norma Holloway JohnsononThursday morning.Starr wants Secret Service agents who guarded President Bill Clinton totestify about their knowledge of allegationsthat the president had a sexual relationship with former White HouseinternMonica Lewinsky and urged her to lieabout it.Clinton has denied the allegations.The Post also quoted sources "close to the situation" as saying thatClintonhad filed a sealed notice that he wouldappeal Johnson's decision last week dismissing an attempt by twopresidentialaides to claim executive privilege.White House spokesman Jim Kennedy declined comment on reports about theappeal, saying the matter was underseal in federal court. Charles Bakaly, spokesman for Starr's office, also declined comment on a sealed matter.Merletti, who served on the details of Presidents Ronald Reagan, GeorgeBushand Clinton during his 24-yeartenure with the Secret Service, made his case against agents testifying inrecent meetings with Starr and JusticeDepartment officials.During private meetings, sources told the Post, Merletti argued thattrust and proximity were crucial to protecting apresident. Even a few feet of extra distance could keep an agent frombeingclose enough to stop a bullet, hereportedly said. In outlining his arguments, Merletti ran through instances of assassination attempts and produced rare photographs of John Kennedy's fateful 1963 motorcade through Dallas, where agentswere notstanding on running boards on the back of his car when shots rang out because Kennedy several daysearlierordered them not to.SO, THE CURRENT DIRECTOR OF THE SECRET SERVICE HAS CHOSEN TO USE THETRIED AND TRUE "JFK AS SCAPEGOAT" TACTIC TO SUIT HIS PURPOSE.
