Thank you to all of you for your expressions of support. My Dad died today --he just slipped away while they were running some tests on him. My Mother was there at the time and it was very peaceful. I guess you could say he died in his sleep and it is likely that his heart just stopped working. As many of you know, last Thursday, the day after I returned from DC, I received an urgent call from the hospital indicating that they were putting him on life support and that I should hurry to Fargo. By the time I arrived, he had pulled through the crisis and had been slowly improving. He had come out of the coma and was able to speak and sit in a chair. We knew he was very seriously ill, but had some reason for hope based on the past few days. I had been planning on travelling to Fargo tomorrow (Friday) to see him. I have not worked out arrangements with my Mother yet, but Debbie will let you all know. Thanks so much -- I really appreciated the concern that each of you expressed. Jack
