Jeremy - Your mailing of May 28 solicited comments from the public about potential recommendations in your final report. As you may recall, I do have some interest in your recommendations, and I have occasionally offered comments or questions on relevant matters - for example, the possible applicability of the standards of the JFK Act under FOIA. If memory serves, one of the Warren Commission's staff attorneys later regretted that no mechanism had been put in place to deal with the questions that inevitably followed the release of their report.
