Eileen, Here are the topics I want to cover with Judge Tunheim: In the public meeting, the members mentioned that they had hoped more work could have been done in getting records from abroad. What countries are you currently working with, and generally what type of documents are being sought? What is the status of getting the KGB's file on Oswald from Russia? Why is it being sought? Will it be brought up during the Clinton administration's visit next week to Russia? You mentioned to our reporter, Mike Feinsilber, earlier this month that Gore had worked on this issue in the spring. What happened then? Has the board made a decision yet on whether it will depose any more key players before it closes shop? What about the Dallas doctors? Is the board making strides to interview some of them? How likely is it that another board or independent agency will be created as a kind of standing declassification clearinghouse? Why do some of the board members worry that the board's work will be forgotten after such a massive amount of material has been released? Just curious ... what is your reaction to Attorney General Janet Reno's decision earlier this week to reopen the investigation, in a limited way, into the assassination of the Rev.
