**Subject:** 14 September Meeting Summary

**Body:** At its September 14 meeting, the Board released 279 CIA records. These documents dealt primarily with CIA dealings with the HSCA, operations in the Congo, Cuba and Mexico City, including technical coverage of the Cuban and Soviet embassies there, and details of the means used by the CIA to document the aliases used by its agents and employees. Documents on KGB defector Yuri Nosenko and Dutch journalist William Oltmans were also released. A number of these documents were found in the files of Russ Holmes, a CIA officer who dealt with FOIA requests. The Board also released 22 HSCA documents, including the depositions and testimony of Robert Shaw, Anne Goodpasture, and David Atlee Phillips, as well as researcher notes on operations carried on by and personnel stationed at the CIA's Mexico City station.
