Investigative

* Conducted a telephone interview with Dr. David Garrow concerning sources of assassination records created by the CPUSA and its officials. Will send letters to follow up on his several suggested contacts (academics and former party officials.)

* Continued follow up investigations on sources of records in New Orleans. Reviewed New Orleans Public Hearing transcript to develop new sources of assassination records as suggested by hearing witnesses.

* Conducted follow up investigations for additional names and addresses of former HSCA and other investigative entity staff, including an inquiry to the LBJ Presidential Library in Austin, Texas for the Ramsey Clark Panel records.

* Conducted telephone interview with Rebecca Patton, Esq, Counsel to the Illinois State Auditor General, concerning the assassination records of the former Illinois Legislative Investigative Commission.

* Conducted telephone interview with Roger Busbice, Chief Archivist, Office of Secretary of State, State of Louisiana, about his ongoing efforts to facilitate a gift of the original documents from the Clay Shaw trial record to the JFK Collection.

* Opened two new investigative issues. Issue 43 concerns efforts to account for all autopsy photos, x-rays and autopsy material (opened after conversation with Jack and his recommendation that this area be pursived); Issue 44 concerns a letter from Jeanne deMohrenschildt's daughter and the daughter's attorney, alleging that a Dallas FBI employee has assassination records in his possession that had been the property of Jeanne and George deMohrenschildt before their deaths.
